# Notice of Regatta

**Venue:** Pretoria Sailing Club – Rietvlei Dam

**Date:** 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> August 2019

**Registration:** 09h00 on Saturday 24th August 2019.

**Skippers' briefing:** 10h00 on Saturday 24th August 2019.

**Starting time:**

The warning signal for the first race on Saturday the 24th of August will be at 11h00. The times for subsequent races will be displayed on the Regatta Notice Board. An “L” flag flown on the Bridge at the finish of a race will indicate a “back to back” race.

The last race will not commence after 15h30 on Sunday the 25th of August unless required to complete the regatta, and only after agreement with class representatives.

**Rules:** The regatta will be sailed under the ISAF 2017/2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the SAS prescriptions thereto and the rules of the Finn and 505 classes.

**Eligibility:** The skipper and crew of each competing yacht shall be a member in good standing of any SAS-affiliated club and of their respective class associations.

**No. of races:** The regatta will consist of a maximum of 8 races. A minimum of 4 races must be sailed. If only 4 races are sailed, all will count. If 5 to 8 races are sailed there will be 1 discard

**Entry fee:** Entry fee for the Finn Class: R150  
Entry fee for the 505 Class: R200

Entries will be accepted at the venue prior to the start of racing.

**Sailing instructions:**

Sailing Instructions and course cards will be available from the Regatta Office. In general PSC Club Courses will be sailed, but the Race Officer may choose to set Olympic Courses or Windward/Leeward Courses if the wind direction is favourable. This Notice of Regatta forms part of the Sailing Instructions.

**Scoring:** The low-points scoring system, as set out in Appendix A4, will apply. Ties will be broken in accordance with ISF RR Appendix A8 “Series Ties”.

**Penalties:** Penalty turns will be in accordance with Clause 44.1 of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

**Access to the Club:**

Gate 2 to PSC will be open, to allow easy access for visitors.

**Liability:** Competitors compete entirely at their own risk. None of the organisations or persons concerned with the running of the regatta will accept any liability for any damage or injuries that may be suffered at any time during the regatta.

**Prize giving:** A prize giving will take place after the last race on Sunday.
