### Sailing

- This Regatta will be held **in accordance with the Covid regulations** in place at the time. Social distancing, face masks and appropriate behaviour must be kept at all times.
- Temperature taking and signing in must be completed by all competitors, members and other visitors daily at the committee room.
- Changing rooms will be open, but no more than 10 persons at a time to ensure social distancing.
- **ALL VISITOR BOATS PLEASE EMAIL SHIRLEY ADDISON, OUR ADMINISTRATOR [admin@psc.org.za](mailto:admin@psc.org.za), AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE REGATTA, SO WE CAN NOTIFY THE MAIN GATE TO REITVLEI RESERVE IN ORDER TO MAKE APPROPRIATE ARRANGEMENTS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN YOU PAYING ADDITIONAL FEES TO ENTER THE RESERVE.**
- This regatta is open to all mono-hull dinghy classes up to 6.7 meters
- The regatta incorporates the Finn Highveld Championships.
- The skipper and crew should be members of a SAS-affiliated club.
- Five or more boats must enter to form a class. Boats not forming a class will form part of the Open Class.
- The 2021 – 25 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing will govern the regatta.
- Registration: entries for the Charity Regatta will be accepted at the venue **from 8:30 to 09:30** on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
- **Entry fees will be R400.00 per two-man senior boat and R300.00 per senior single-handed boat for the 4 day regatta.**
- **Juniors are reduced in price again this year. They will be R150.00 per two-man boat and R100.00 per single-handed boat.** Skipper and crew (if sailing a two-man boat) must be under 19 years of age to be considered as a junior and must sail a junior recognised class boat.
- Depending on Covid regulations and the weather, we will aim to have a bring and braai on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> April. Further details at the skippers briefing at 1100 on the Saturday.
- Sailing Instructions will be available at the PSC Committee Room and registration tables.
- The warning signal for the first race will not be before 11:30 on the Saturday morning.
- No more than 15 races will be sailed with five races making a regatta. One discard if 5+ races are sailed. Two discards if 10+ races are sailed, 3 discards if 15 races are sailed.
- The Courses to be sailed will be either club courses or Olympic. Course cards showing the club courses will be issued on registration at the registration desk.

### Accommodation

- Free camping is available on the PSC premises. For camping details or bookings please contact Shirley Addison not later than **20<sup>th</sup> April 2021**.
